### 26<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL DANCE UNLIMITED RECITALS

Our 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Recitals are on Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup> at the McPherson Playhouse. There are 2 *different* shows at 11:30am and 5:30pm. All dancers take part in the recital. The dress rehearsals are as follows: 11:30am show rehearsal is Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup> from 3:30-9:00pm and 5:30pm show rehearsal is Wednesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> from 3:30-9:00pm. Dancers MUST attend the dress rehearsals if they plan on participating in the recitals. Dancers do not need to attend the entire dress rehearsal if they are only in one half of the show. *Tickets for both recitals will go on sale Saturday, April 27<sup>th</sup> through the McPherson Box Office.*

PLEASE DO NOT PURCHASE A TICKET FOR YOUR CHILD as they will be with parent chaperones for the duration of the show. Ticket prices include the theatre service charges and tax and are \$25.25 for adults and \$22.25 for children and seniors. \* A note from the McPherson - "Please note that we will not have Select Your Own Seat enabled during the initial on sale period based on customer experience last year. Because our website transacts in real time, it leads to a lot of confusion when demand is high when tickets first go on sale. We will monitor it and turn it on as soon as we deem it feasible. This means that they won't be able to look at the map online and choose their seats. It will be best available only. Over the phone and in person they will have a choice, but not online. Sales happen too fast and the ability to choose their own seats is incredibly resource heavy."

A list of which show/s your child will be in is attached to this Newsletter. Only the Companies, Crews and Adult Jazz classes perform in both recitals. A reminder that if your child is in more than 1 class they may be in both shows which will require a separate ticket for each show. We have done our best to avoid this. Thank you for your understanding.

### CLASS PICTURES - May 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> NEW DATES

- Class pictures are May 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. Regular classes are still on these days. If you don't want pictures, we ask that your child still be there so the entire class is in the picture. These are the photos that are used in the Recital program so your child will want to be there!
- If you are ordering pictures, on picture day you will need:
  - \$17.00 per class (includes individual and class photo) (OACP's get 2 5x7's - individual & group)
  - Payment can be made by cash (**no change available**), cheque payable to Gordon Lee Photography or Visa/ MC and MUST BE PAID AT TIME OF PHOTO TAKEN. **Please do not drop your child off and then bring the payment back as they won't be photographed for an individual.**
- Order envelopes will be available on picture day and must be handed in at the time the photo is taken.
- Please dress your child in recital costume and have hair done as specified for recital. Make-up is brown eye shadow, brown/ black eyeliner & mascara, light blush and red lipstick. Boys do not need make up.
- The schedule is VERY tight so please be on time. We cannot wait for latecomers and please be patient if we happen to fall behind. Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time so you don't get left out!
- A list of photo day times will be sent out by email by this Sunday.
